Report of the Administrative Commission for Divine Savior/St Andrew

The Administrative Commission continues to work with both churches to determine their individual future direction. At this time, Divine Savior has a fully functioning session and has attendance ranging from 35 to 70. Lucretia Chew continues to serve as Treasurer and she and Jimmy Stevens are working with the pastor, church, contractor and Project Vida to clear up issues resulting from the recent completion of the apartments built by Vida and the new parking lot at Divine Savior.

Divine Savior would like to continue with the Designated Pastor role for Rev. Ruiz for the twelve months ended 12/31/17 and will have a congregational meeting to confirm their intent on November 6, 2016.

St. Andrew is studying options for their future, but desires that Rev. Ruiz continue as the Designated Pastor through mid-2017. Their attendance is now in the range of 12-20 and finances are becoming much more challenging. The AC will be working with the church to explore their options.

The Administrative Commission will meet again with both churches on Thursday December 1st, specifically to finalize action plans during 2017. It is hoped that the AC can dissolve at the end of 2017.

Report of the Administrative Commission for Grace Presbyterian Chapel, San Angelo

The report was presented by Don Carlton.

I. Matters of Information

At its February 21, 2015 Stated Meeting, the Presbytery appointed an Administrative Commission to work in partnership with the members of First Presbyterian Church, San Angelo who desired to remain in the PC(USA) and who had signed a letter of intent expressing their desire to unite together to form a continuing PC(USA) congregation. Duties of the AC were to provide guidance and support to the members as it seeks to develop its identity, mission and ministry as a congregation. Loyal PCUSA members began worshipping together in January, 2015, and continue to date nesting in the chapel of First Christian Church, San Angelo. An initial steering committee was appointed for the group, and following their official recognition as the continuing congregation at the called meeting of presbytery in June, 2015, a congregational nominating committee was appointed in the fall. Elders were then elected, trained, examined and installed by the Administrative Commission. An interim moderator was appointed by the AC and the session quickly filed Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State as a 501(c)(3) corporation. Bylaws have been drafted to be adopted by the congregation. In June 2016, the Missional Ministries Team appointed Elder Bernie Coffee as moderator of the session to assist them in securing pastoral leadership.

On behalf of the AC, it has been a rewarding experience to partner with the faithful members of Grace Presbyterian Chapel during this period of reorganization, and we extend our best wishes and prayers for their continued success.

II. Matters of a Routine Nature (Actions taken on behalf of presbytery)

- A. Approved transferring \$87,500 of the funds held in trust for Grace Presbyterian Chapel by the presbytery for their use and benefit. This amount represents the agreed upon terms for the first and second years of the settlement agreement with FPC, San Angelo.
- B. Approved authorizing the Missional Resource Team to transfer the remaining third year payment held in trust of \$37,500 to Grace Presbyterian Chapel in June 2017.
- C. Approved authorizing the Missional Resource Team to provide oversight and transfer the \$50,000 of Second Harvest Funds budgeted by presbytery for Grace Presbyterian Chapel when request is submitted by the session.
- D. Approved that the following be admitted into presbytery's records:
 - 1. Minutes of Called Congregational Meeting 11-8-15
 - 2. Minutes of Called Congregational Meeting 12-20-15
 - 3. Minutes of AC teleconference 9-9-16

III. Recommendations For More Careful Consideration

Report of the Missional Ministries Team

The report was presented by Craig Holstedt and received as information.

The Missional Ministries Team met most recently by conference call on September 8, 2016. Since the last meeting of Presbytery, MMT reports the following:

I. Items of Information

- 1. MMT approved a six month (6) extension of the Interim Pastor Contract between Buddy Monahans and Westminster, beginning August 31st.
- 2. MMT approved the MIF for Westminster Presbyterian Church, Odessa, TX for circulation.

- 3. MMT approved the MIF for Grace Chapel Presbyterian Church, San Angelo, TX for circulation.
- 4. The congregation of Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church of Sonora, TX completed the Discernment Process and voted to stay in the PCUSA. They have submitted a letter to promote further closure and reconciliation with the Presbytery. Therefore MMT has now dismissed the Discernment Team with appreciation for their work.
- 5. Rev. Tim Davenport-Herbst was appointed to represent MMT on the commission to review the proposed amendments from GA and make a report to the February meeting of Presbytery.
- 6. The issue of BOP Vacancy Dues for the Marfa congregation has been resolved and the congregation did not have to pay them.
- 7. MMT continues to work with various congregations in the Presbytery to provide support with ministry issues, pastoral searches, changing ministries, etc.

Report of the Next Steps Task Force

The report was presented by Gary Dill and received as information.

I. Matters of Information

The Next Steps Task Force met on September 7 and affirmed these operating assumptions.

- A. The work of the task force will conclude with recommendations to review with the networking team in September, 2017, for action by presbytery at its October, 2017, meeting.
- B. Meet at least once in each of the four clusters of the presbytery during the year's work.
- C. Describe the "current reality" in the Presbytery and its congregations including the Presbytery's structure and financial resources by compiling existing quantitative data and collecting additional qualitative, narrative information about the presbytery's congregations and ministries [Gary will consult with Theresa Wright about gathering the quantitative data; Susan Delano will work on gathering the qualitative data].
- D. Provide a "map "of the Presbytery showing the congregational distribution.
- E. Examine the geographical boundaries of the Presbytery considering whether adjustments to those boundaries ought to be addressed [Neal].

- F. Consider the Goals and Purpose of Tres Rios Presbytery and the roles Presbytery should play in achieving those goals reflecting guidance from the Book of Order [Matt].
- G. Review Presbytery's staffing needs relative to these findings and observations.
- H. A progress report will be presented at the February, 2017, Presbytery meeting.

The next meeting will be held at St. Mark's Presbyterian Church in San Angelo at 1 p.m., 10/13/16. Also, a meeting will be held in Marfa 1/13/17.



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Special Called Meeting of the Presbytery of Tres Rios Grace Presbyterian Church, Midland, Texas August 31, 2016

The Special Called Meeting of the Presbytery of Tres Rios was called to order with prayer by Moderator, Jobeth McLeod on Wednesday, August 31, 2016 at 1:40 p.m. in the sanctuary of Grace Presbyterian Church, Midland Texas.

Stated Clerk Kay Long declared a quorum present and read the call for the meeting. It was MOVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED that the call for the meeting be approved. It was MOVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED that the docket be approved.

The report of the Presbytery Negotiating Task Force was presented by Mark Morgan

The Discernment Team was formed following the vote by First Midland to enter into the discernment process in March of 2015. The team met for the first time in April and after discussion selected Mike Murray to facilitate the discussion of the team. Mike did a great job of bringing the team together to work on a common goal. We defined our task to discern whether the First Presbyterian Church of Midland should remain a member of the Presbyterian Church (USA) or request dismissal to another reformed denomination, in light of: 1) our understanding of God's will for FPC Midland and for Tres Rios Presbytery, and 2) what we believe to be the best for the First Presbyterian Church of Midland and its ability to carry out its mission. Through bible study and prayer, we developed a plan to address questions and concerns, and then to meet with the congregation in small numbers in family homes. We wanted everyone to be comfortable in the conversation, provide the opportunity for all voices to be heard, and one in which strong personalities did not push or monopolized the conversation. We prepared a program that involved reflection, prayer, discussion, bible study and congregational input.

With one representative from the Presbytery and one from First, Midland at each meeting, we met with 28 different groups over a six week period and collected over 300 written responses. The meetings went very well, attendance ranged from 5 to 30. I believe that anyone that attended felt that their voice was heard. There was no overwhelming sense to leave the denomination. The written responses were weighted in the other direction; there was much concern about First Midland's way if it continued in the PCUSA. In the end, the team determined that the congregation above all wanted to have a vote to determine its way. The team recommended to the session at First Midland that they vote to determine their future.

On Sunday, November 1, 2015, 591 of the 1,313 active members were present for the congregational meeting, and voted 446 (75%) to 145 (25%) to request that the Presbytery of Tres Rios dismiss the congregation of First Presbyterian Church, Midland to ECO: A Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians. In accordance with the Reconciliation and Dismissal Policy previously adopted by the Presbytery, the required quorum of active members (30%) was met.

The Presbytery's Negotiating Team held its first meeting on December 7, 2015 following the vote by First Midland to seek dismissal from the PCUSA. From the beginning, the team felt it was important to address any concerns that the members of the church might have over the church leaving the PCUSA. A letter was sent to all members of the congregation informing them of a meeting to be held in January to inform them of their personal options in remaining in the PCUSA or in seeking dismissal with the other members. We meet twice with the group and they then decided to explore which direction they would take and began meeting on their own.

Representatives of the First, Midland Team began to prepare and provide information to the Presbytery Team. The two teams met in March to discuss the terms of the dismissal. There were wide differences in the reasons and the amount of any settlement. The Presbytery team met several times over the next few months to develop a better picture of the financial position of First Midland, and to consider how we might bridge the gap between the two teams. A counter proposal was then offered, but not accepted.

After much prayer and discussion, both teams agreed to seek the expertise of professionals in the field of mediation. At this point in time, the Presbytery team felt it would be best to engage the services of legal counsel familiar with the Presbyterian Church (USA) and similar dismissal cases in Texas to prepare and guide us through the mediation process. The First, Midland Team also engaged their own legal counsel. On August 3rd, we met for mediation, and through the skills of an independent mediator were able to negotiate a settlement agreement. Though each side held firmly to their ground throughout the process, it was ultimately agreed by both that coming to terms benefited all. The attached settlement agreement is the final product of this mediated process.

Finally, it should be noted that renegotiation of the terms of the agreements and request for dismissal through use of amendments from the floor of presbytery would invalidate months of work between the representatives of the presbytery and members of the congregation. Therefore the following Matters "B thru D" shall be presented as a whole, with the understanding that the final agreement has been reached by good faith negotiations between the presbytery and the representatives of the session and members of the congregation requesting dismissal.

(Note: Motion A requires two-thirds vote of presbytery. Motions "B thru D" require only a simple majority vote.)

The Negotiating Task Force appointed by presbytery makes the following recommendations:

A. That the following Matters "B thru D" regarding the dismissal of the members of First Presbyterian Church of Midland, Texas shall be considered as a whole and that amendments to these motions to dismiss the congregation and the "Compromise Settlement Agreement and Mutual Full Release of Claims" Agreement", "Deed Without Warranty", and "Bill of Sale and Blanket Assignment" documents from the floor of presbytery not be permitted. The vote on the request for dismissal and the terms will be either yes or no.

It was MOVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED that Recommendation III A be approved.

B. That all members of First Presbyterian Church of Midland, Texas requesting dismissal from the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) be dismissed to the Presbytery of Texas and Louisiana, ECO: A Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians, a reformed body and member of the World Communion of Reformed Churches (WCRC), together with the real and personal property of the church as stipulated in the "Compromise Settlement Agreement and Mutual Full Release of Claims", "Deed Without Warranty" (quitclaim deed), and "Bill of Sale and Blanket Assignment" documents. First Presbyterian Church of Midland, Texas will be permitted to retain the name and corporate entity, and will remove the P.C. (U.S.A.) seal from all property and documents. The Presbytery of Tres Rios will be given a digitalized copy of all church records, rolls, certificates and documents within 30 days of the effective date of dismissal. Effective date of dismissal shall be August 31, 2016. (Note: legal description of all real property to be released described in "Exhibit "A" of the "Deed Without Warranty" and personal property in the "Bill of Sale and Blanket Assignment")

- C. That Presbytery authorize its Trustees to sign and deliver on behalf of the Presbytery of Tres Rios 1) the "Compromise Settlement Agreement and Mutual Full Release of Claims", 2) "Deed Without Warranty", 3) "Bill of Sale and Blanket Assignment", and 4) written confirmation of dismissal of the entity and congregation of FPC Midland from the PCUSA to ECO to the offices of Craddock, Davis & Krause LLP, c/o Kent C. Krause, 3100 Monticello Avenue, Suite 550, Dallas, Texas 75205, which will be the Escrow Agent to be held in trust until the final installment payment is made. After the final installment payment is made, Escrow Agent may release the "Deed Without Warranty" and "Bill of Sale and Blanket Assignment" to FPC, Midland.
- D. That the Presbytery of Tres Rios retain a roll of any members of First P.C. Midland who notify the Stated Clerk in writing of their wish to retain their membership in the P.C. (U.S.A.) until they decide upon a congregation to join and transfer their membership. The roll will be retained by Presbytery until September 1, 2018. After that date, any members on the roll who have not requested a transfer of their membership to a congregation will be contacted by letter, and if no instructions are given, their membership will be transferred to the roll of a local PCUSA congregation.

The Presbytery of Tres Rios has received confirmation that the Presbytery of Texas and Louisiana of, ECO: A Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians will assume ecclesiastical authority for members of the congregation and pastors expressing their desire to be dismissed pending dismissal from the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

It was MOVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED that Recommendation B-D be approved. The vote was 25 in favor, 1 Against and 2 Abstain

The report of the Missional Ministries Team was presented by Craig Holstedt

MMT recommends:

- A. That the Presbytery of Tres Rios concurs with the request of teaching elder the Rev. Steven Schorr to be dismissed from the P.C. (U.S.A.) to the Presbytery of Texas and Louisiana, ECO: A Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians effective August 31, 2016.
- B. That the Presbytery of Tres Rios concurs with the request of teaching elder the Rev. Walter Thompson to be dismissed from the P.C. (U.S.A.) to the Presbytery of Texas and Louisiana, ECO: A Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians effective August 31, 2016.

The Presbytery of Tres Rios has received confirmation that the Presbytery of Texas and Louisiana, ECO will assume ecclesiastical authority for both of the above named teaching elders, as well as, members of the congregation expressing their desire to be dismissed pending dismissal from the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

It was MOVED, SECONDED AND CARRIED that Recommendation A and B be approved. The vote was 24 in favor, 1 against, 1 Abstain

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned with a service of prayer followed by communion at 2:45 p.m.
